What are your hockey credentials?

I have been in pro hockey for 20 years. I have worked in several different leagues including the CHL, AHL, IHL, and the NHL. I am currently the equipment manager for the Dallas Stars.



How often should a player get his/her skates sharpened?

Players should get their skates sharpened if they have any nicks or missing edges. Hockey is a dangerous sport. If a player is missing an edge they could fall go into the boards and get injured. I sharpen the Stars players' skates every game day.

Do you sharpen skates differently according to position/age?

Yes, I do sharpen skates differently for players depending on weight and position.

What will make your shop and service different from the rest?

My employees will be taught by me personally. And I will expect them to bring the same professionalism to my customers as I do for the Dallas stars players.
